

The Prix Solo *artmonte-carlo* - F.P.Journe awarded to the gallery Nathalie Obadia, for the artwork "Oiseaux du paradis" by Guillaume Leblon

The gallery, leader in the contemporary art, will open soon a new address on Faubourg Saint-Honoré in Paris, close to the F.P.Journe Boutique.
